"It is impossible to win a battle without first intending to win it." – the late French politician and philosopher Charles de Gaulle, winner of the world war. The world in which we are living currently has two dominant styles of leadership; one which ignores globalization and one which is embracing it. Countries dominated by the former are more isolated and their citizens find it harder to get to work in other countries. Those countries dominated by the latter, which is the policy of Senegal, are more active in globalization, attract foreign investment and are more economically and socially stable.
